Offering safe homes to youths and adults in need of stability and independence

HSVS helps youth and adults combat homelessness.



HSVS helps youths and adults achieve stability through a safe home.

HeartShare St. Vincent's Services nurtures and empowers thousands of vulnerable New Yorkers each year. The Supported Housing Program helps those facing homelessness.

Supported housing, coupled with support services, provides an affordable, safe and permanent place to live for youth and adults.

Through referrals, HSVS supportive apartments help youth aging out of care, as well as adults and families struggling with substance abuse, mental health issues, or are living with HIV/AIDS.

Residents are connected to support services to help them become self-sufficient.

Eligibility

HSVS offers supportive apartments to vulnerable New Yorkers in need of a safe home:

- Individuals 16-26 aging out of care (ACS)
- Individuals released from state incarceration on parole for a minimum of one year
- Individuals discharged from New York State Psychiatric Hospitals
- Individuals or families with HIV/AIDS

Services

In addition to a safe place to live, HSVS Supported Housing offers highly individualized and comprehensive support to ensure that those enrolled in our program are no longer homeless again in their lifetime.

Activities supporting clients' autonomy, safety, health and overall wellbeing are offered in the Supported Housing Program office in downtown Brooklyn.

HeartShare St. Vincent's Services is funded by NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, NYC Human Resources Administration, NYC HIV/AIDS Services Administration, NYS Office of Mental Health, and the generous support of our donors.

For Individuals 16-26 aging out of foster care with a referral from ACS,

- Employment, educational and vocational counseling
- Life skills training, such as budgeting and relationship building skills
- Health care coordination
- Mental health services, if needed

For individuals released from state incarceration on parole with a referral from CUCS,

- Readjustment to the community
- Supportive counseling
- Employment, educational and vocational counseling
- Health care coordination
- Mental health services, if needed
- Substance abuse services, if needed

For individuals with a referral from New York State Psychiatric Hospitals,

- Life skills training
- Peer support training
- Money and medication management
- Health care coordination
- Substance abuse services, if needed

For individuals or families with HIV/AIDS with a referral from HRA,

- Medical case management
- Health care collaboration with medical providers and home care agencies, as needed
- Life skills training
